I. High School District Parcel Tax Renewal (Greg Medici)

The current LGSUHS district parcel tax of \$49 expires at the end of the 2016-2017 school year. The District Board of Trustees is contemplating whether to move forward with a renewal of the parcel tax at the current rate or seek a slightly higher rate of \$89 per parcel. The Trustees are also looking at whether to do a mail-only election in May 2016 or put the parcel tax on the June 2016 ballot. A two-thirds vote is required and all of the money goes to students and classrooms.
